Description:

Annually, hundreds of thousands of adults across North America take the General Educational Development (or GED) Exam in order to get jobs, further their careers, earn promotions, or qualify for further education or training. Passing this exam earns you a certificate that the vast majority of colleges, training schools and employers in the nation recognize as the equivalent of a high school diploma.

Details:

The GED Preparation (Tutoring) Program at Transitions College of Business and Career Studies consists of training for those wishing to prepare for their GED Exam. The GED Exam is a series of five tests which (when passed) certifies that the taker has Canadian high-school academic skills. In Ontario, the Independent Learning Centre offers tests at various locations (www.ilc.org/ged).
